SIGN UP FOR A SHIFT (10 a.m. - 1 p.m. - 1 p.m.- 4 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m.) by CONTACTING Jason at 517-285-6438 or schedules@fairfieldcountyintergroup.org (If you're an individual you can pick a time you'd like to sign up for or if your group would like to pass around a sheet for people to sign up - the group can elect an Intergroup Rep to coordinate this). The sheets are emailed to the Reps over a week in advance of each upcoming month. Choose as many slots as you think you're group members can fill. Group slots are given randomly (can't pick the times).

GROUP REPS - ATTEND ONE MEETING (1st Wednesday of each month at the Star Facility in Norwalk, 7:30, 182 Wolfpit Road, Main entrance, room off to the left of Recept. desk), PICK UP GROUP NEWSLETTERS, DISCUSS ANY ISSUES AND BRING INFORMATION BACK TO THE GROUPS.

ANOTHER OPTION: If you can't commit to a shift or you don't attend a group that passes a sheet, GET ORIENTED. SUBMIT YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS to Jason at 517-285-6438 or schedules@fairfieldcountyintergroup.org. When a group realizes a shift they have isn't being taken, they notify Jason and he sends out an email. In this way someone volunteers to fill it and the timeslot won't go unfilled. This has been working nicely.
