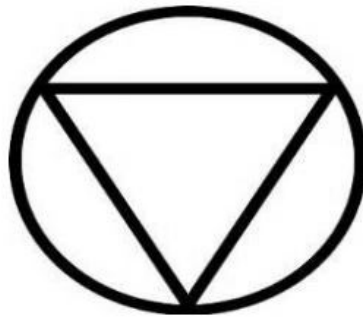

FROM THE IAFC BOARD—HOW TO:

Join Intergroup: Elect a Rep. from your group or send a group member to the open Intergroup Rep Meeting held the 1st Wednesday of the month 7:30PM at Star, 182 Wolfpit Ave., Norwalk. The Representative Trustee who leads the meeting will give you a packet with everything you need to know. Join Intergroup & other groups in carrying the message to the sick & suffering!

Answer Phones: Ask your Rep how to sign-up for a phone shift. You must have 90 days in order to answer phones. Orientation is also required. It is held on the 3rd Monday of every month from 7-10PM at 83 East Ave., Norwalk. Suite 211. Only takes 10 minutes!
