IAFC is an A.A. service office that involves partnership among groups in the Fairfield County area, just as A.A. groups themselves are partners with individuals. Established to carry out certain functions common to all the groups, these functions are best handled by a centralized office. We are maintained, supervised, and supported by these groups in their general interest. We exist to aid the AA groups in our area with their common purpose of carrying the AA message to the alcoholic who still suffers.

FROM THE IAFC BOARD—HOW TO:

Join Intergroup: Elect a Rep. from your group or send a group member to the open Intergroup Rep Meeting held the 1st Wednesday of the month 7:30PM at Star, 182 Wolfpit Ave., Norwalk. The Representative Trustee who leads the meeting will give you a packet with everything you need to know. Join Intergroup & other groups in carrying the message to the sick & suffering!

Answer Phones: Ask your Rep how to sign-up for a phone shift. You must have 90 days in order to answer phones. Orientation is also required. It is held on the 3rd Monday of every month from 7-10PM at 83 East Ave., Norwalk. Suite 211. Only takes 10 minutes!

Donate to Intergroup: Your group doesn't have to join Intergroup to support the services it provides. Send donations to P.O Box 1605 Darien, CT. There are guidelines on what to give Intergroup from both Area & in the Treasurer's kit. IAFC Treasurer reports available upon request. We maintain a secure office that houses the AA hotline for Districts 5&6, including an answering service to take calls when there aren't alcoholics there. This is a vital service to our Districts, & gives groups & individuals the opportunity to do 12th step work.
